SECTION C-3.10 Members of Member Congregations.

For the purposes of these Bylaws, a member of a member congregation is any individual who pursuant to its procedures has full or partial voting rights at business meetings of the congregation and who is certified as such by an authorized officer of the congregation.

SECTION 4.8. Delegates.

(a) Member Delegates. Each certified member congregation is entitled to be represented at each General Assembly by delegates who are members of such congregation, selected in accordance with its bylaws or procedures.

PROPOSED PROCEDURES FOR DELEGATE SELECTION

To be a representative to an organization to which the First Unitarian Church pays denominational dues, an individual must be:

- 1. A sustaining member of the Church who has been in this status for at least one year prior to appointment. Said one membership requirement may be waived by a two thirds vote of the Board of Trustees.
- 2. Appointed by the President of the Board of Trustees.
- 3. Approved by a vote of the Board of Trustees.
