Designated Collection - Sunday July 14th - Partner Church Fund

The Partner Church Program's purpose is to maintain and expand the relationship between First Unitarian of St. Louis and our partner church in Csókfalva, Romania. Our on-going programs are providing scholarships to worthy students to attend a nearby Unitarian Church High School and/or other schools and providing a supplement to our Partner Church minister's meager salary. The Committee financially assists our Partner Church in projects that enhance the church or parsonage. Examples of these projects have been restoring a gate in front of the vicarage, building a new front porch on the vicarage to provide outdoor gathering space, and insulating the vicarage. A longer term restoration project will be to help weatherize and stabilize the tower on the historic church building. Funds are also raised to help support visits between our congregations in Csókfalva and St. Louis.

of a Sunday plate collection. Nominations are reviewed by the Social Responsibility Committee (SRC) with consideration given to the fit between the nominee and First Church's mission and values, as well as the nonprofit's core focus, impact, and connection to our First Church community.
